Fast-paced and brassy with great immortal songs (including *Guys and Dolls*, *Sit Down You’re Rockin’ the Boat*, *The Oldest Established Permanent Floating Crap Game*, *Take Back Your Mink*, *I’ve Never been in Love Before*, *If I Were a Bell*, *Luck Be a Lady Tonight* and many more), fantastic dance sequences (in night clubs and in a sewer!) and exciting, hilarious dialogue!
